MEETING POINT DESCRIPTION

We meet in King Tomislav Sq. just across Zagreb Central Railway Station, in front of King Tomislav monument (check the pictures above).

ARRIVING AT THE MEETING POINT

You have multiple options to reach the meeting point.



You can take tramway/streetcar numbers **2, 4, 6, 9, 13, or 14** in the direction of Zagreb Central Station (Glavni kolodvor). Tram tickets purchased at the kiosk cost €0.53 (cash or card) for a 30-minute ride. Alternatively, tickets can be purchased on the tram from the driver at a cost of €0.80 (cash only). For more ticket options, follow the link below. Ticket punching machines are usually positioned at both the front and rear of the tram.

For those arriving by car, parking spaces are accessible at the train station at €1.60/h, but maximum stay is only 2h.

Alternatively, you can find parking at **Branimir Center**, Ulica kneza Trpimira 4, for €1.80/h, just an 8-minute walk or 1 tram stop away from our meeting spot. Take any westbound tram at **Branimirova tram stop** and get off at the next stop. For tram ticket information, see above.
